Advantis looks to a competitor to find its new top exec

Advantis has hired a new CEO and president to take the retiring Bob Corwin's spot.

The credit union said Friday Jason Werts will assume the role Aug. 31. Werts is familiar with Advantis from the other side: He was most recently executive vice president and COO for Unitus Community Credit Union, where he spent 14 years in other top roles.

Werts also spent time in management positions at Wells Fargo. He has some 30 years of financial services expertise.

He's further served on the board of directors at Good Neighbor Center and Children's Cancer Association.

He'll take over Oregon's fifth-largest credit union. Advantis manages \$1.6 billion in assets and counts nine branches that serve 77,000 members.
